ECT DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS

- Activity Rest today. A responsible person must stay with you for 8 hours after discharge form the Hospital. Do not drive a motor vehicle or operate any machinery for 24 hours. Do not make any complex decisions or execute any legal documents while your ECT treatments are every 3 weeks or more often and not on days of or near your treatment. If you have any questions regarding this, speak with your psychiatrist first.
- 2. Diet Start with clear liquids and progress gradually to your usual diet if not nauseated. No alcoholic beverages for 24 hours.
- **3.** Medications Take your daily medications as prescribed. If you physician has prescribed medication for you after your ECT, take as directed.
- 4. You may experience the following after your treatment:
 - a. Poor memory
 - b. Poor balance
 - c. Headaches
 - d. Confusion
 - e. Muscle soreness
 - f. Nausea

- 5. Special Precautions Contact you physician immediately if these occur:
 - a. Signs of infection: redness, swelling, heat, red streaks at the site of the IV
 - b. Excessive pain unrelieved by prescription pain medications
 - c. Nausea and vomiting that persists beyond the first day after your procedure
